NOAA's Office of National Marine Sanctuaries is establishing a Sanctuary Advisory Council for the proposed Hudson Canyon National Marine Sanctuary. We are seeking to fill the following voting seats:

Applications are accepted through **January 31, 2023**. The proposed Hudson Canyon National Marine Sanctuary Advisory Council was established pursuant to federal law to ensure public input to help sanctuary management. Per the charter, voting members and alternates are appointed for a term of three years, and may compete for reappointment.
