Managed by NOAA’s Office of National Marine Sanctuaries, Mallows Bay-Potomac River National Marine Sanctuary, designated in 2019, protects and interprets the remnants of more than 100 World War I-era wooden steamships – known as the "Ghost Fleet". At this synergy of history and nature, there’s something for everyone, whether you prefer to walk the shore, view wildlife, fish, or paddle the waters. The ships emerge at low tide and provide habitat important to osprey, bald eagles, herons, and an array of fish, plants, and animals.
