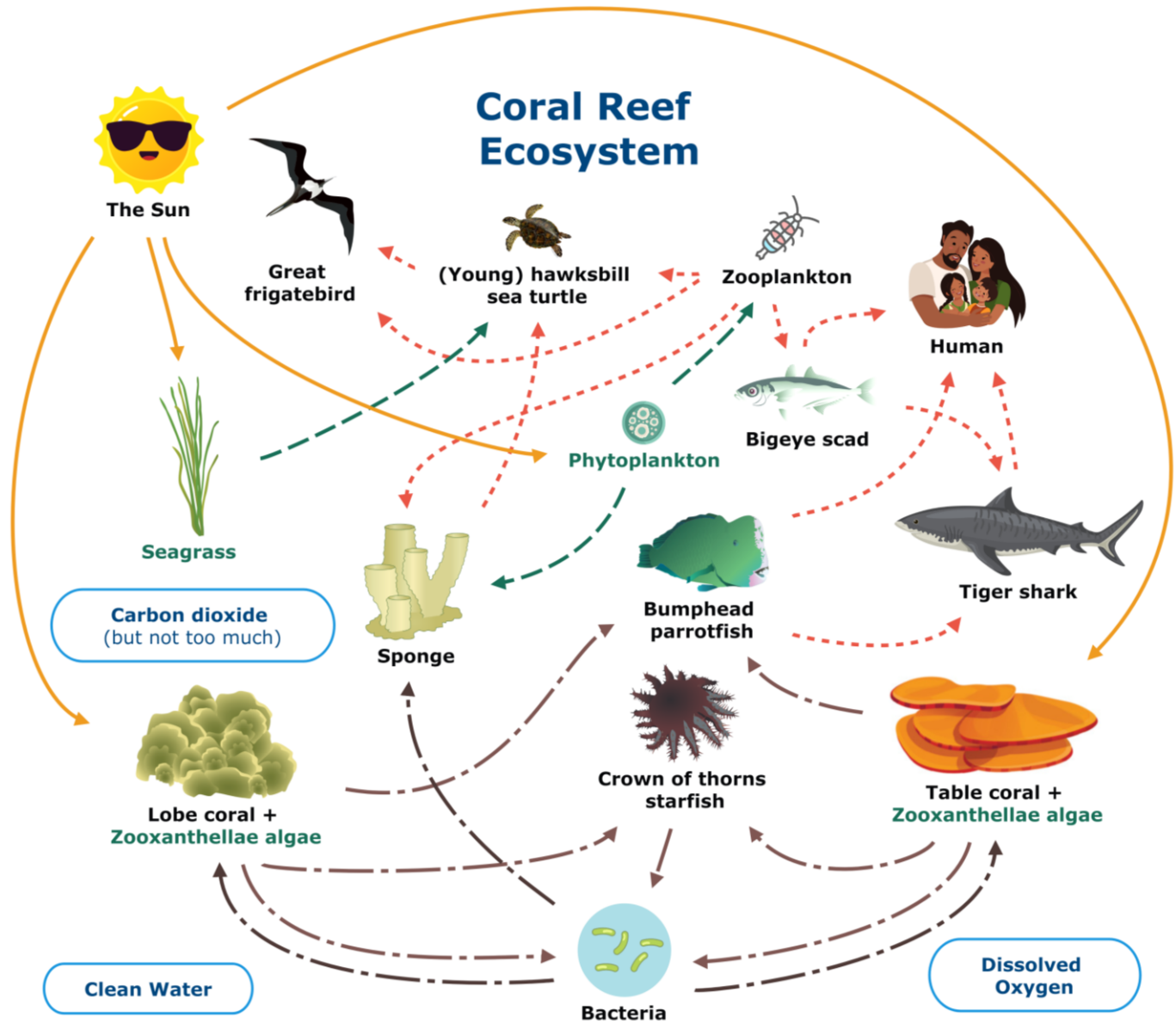




Concept Map Example



Key

- **Orange**, solid arrows show the flow of solar energy to producers (plants)
- **Green**, large-dash arrows show the flow of energy from producers to primary consumers (herbivores)
- **Red**, small-dash arrows show the flow of energy to secondary consumers (predators)
- **Brown**, alternating large-small dash arrows connect corals with organisms they interact with (since they are animals with a symbiotic relationship with photosynthetic algae)
- **Brown**, alternating large-small dash arrows also connect decomposers to organisms they interact with
